



LITERACY

Reading - word reading KS1

- e64 read words containing common suffixes
- e65 read further common exception words, noting unusual correspondences between spelling and sound and where these occur in the word
- e68 re-read these books to build up their fluency and confidence in word reading.

Reading - comprehension KS1

- e71 discussing the sequence of events in books and how items of information are related
- e81 making inferences on the basis of what is being said and done

Writing - transcription - Spelling KS1

- e88 learning to spell common exception words
- e89 learning to spell more words with contracted forms
- e90 learning the possessive apostrophe (singular) [for example, the girl's book]
- e92 add suffixes to spell longer words, including -ment, -ness, -ful, -less, -ly

Writing - handwriting KS1

- e97 write capital letters and digits of the correct size, orientation and relationship to one another and to lower case letters

Writing - composition KS1

- e111 proof-reading to check for errors in spelling, grammar and punctuation [for example, ends of sentences punctuated correctly]

Writing - vocabulary, grammar and punctuation KS1

- e116 sentences with different forms: statement, question, exclamation, command
- e117 expanded noun phrases to describe and specify [for example, the blue butterfly]
- e118 the present and past tenses correctly and consistently including the progressive form
- e119 subordination (using when, if, that, or because) and co-ordination (using or, and, or but)

MATHEMATICS AND COMPUTING

Number - addition and subtraction KS1

- m38 solve problems with addition and subtraction:
- m48 recognise and use the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction and use this to check calculations and solve missing number problems.

Number - multiplication and division KS1

- m52 solve problems involving multiplication and division, using materials, arrays, repeated addition, mental methods, and multiplication and division facts, including problems in contexts.

This half term Year 2 will be consolidating the 4 operations and using them to solve word problems.
Week 1 and 2- the focus will be in addition and subtraction.
Week 3 and 4- the focus will be on multiplication and division.
Week 5 - Transition week. The children will be focusing on number bonds and place value.
Week 6 and 7- The focus will be on applying knowledge of measures to solve word problems.

English
This half term the children will focus on classic texts (Aesop's Fables) & familiar, contemporary texts.
Week 1: Introduce Aesop. Who was he? What is a fable?
Week 2: Read a variety of fables. De-construct fables. What is the moral in each? Plan & write own version of a fable.
Week 3: Read a variety of fables. What are the features of a fable? Plan & write own version of a fable.
Week 4: Poetry - 'The Willow Pattern'. Read the poem which tells the story behind the willow pattern design. Create own adventure story from this stimulus.
Week 5 & 6: 'Handa's Surprise, from this familiar, contemporary text
The children are to write their own version of the story based in their local area.
