

Literacy

Continuous Provision - Listen to stories, songs and rhymes, phonic small group time including identifying letters by sounds, discussing events, reading and writing opportunities both indoor and outdoors.

Other provision - Hear and say set 1 sounds, look and recognise some letters in our names, Repeat words or phrases from familiar stories. Listen out for rhyming words.

Weekly Provision

- Week 1 - Halloween and Bonfire Night - Funny Bones, Story of Guy Fawkes.
- Week 2 - Maths Launch Week - Looking and addition and takeaway signs.
- Week 3 - Friendship Week - What are friends for. My Special Friend activity
- Week 4 - Road Safety Week — Road Safety story. Reading Safety signs.
- Week 5 - Light and Dark— Owl Babies. Writing names for owl babies.
- Week 6 - The First Christmas- Story of Mary and Joseph. Reading Christmas cake recipe.
- Week 7- Christmas at Home- The Jolly Christmas Postman. Writing inserts of Christmas cards.
- Week 8 - Xmas Party—Daily Christmas stories.



Maths

Continuous Provision - Listen to no. stories, songs and rhymes, maths small group time, story time, opportunities 1-5, 5-10, 10-20, matching numeral and quantity, mathematics opportunities both indoor and outdoors..

Other provision - Selecting 2,3,4 objects from a larger group. Recognising 2d shapes. Match number and quantity. Use words for different sizes.

Weekly Provision

- Week 1 - Halloween and Bonfire Night - Counting fireworks.
- Week 2 - Maths Launch Week - Recognising numerals and matching numerals to quantities.
- Week 3 - Friendship Week - Selecting objects from a larger group.
- Week 4 - Road Safety Week — Identifying 2d shapes.
- Week 5 - Light and Dark— Make marks to represent numbers.
- Week 6 - The First Christmas— Categorise objects according to shape or size.
- Week 7- Christmas at Home— Use simple language to differentiate size.
- Week 8 - Xmas Party— Look at time, time different games, activities.

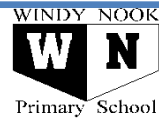

Communication and Language

Continuous Provision - Circle time activities, stories, songs and rhymes. Learning new words and using them. Listen and responds to familiar sounds.

Other provision - Discuss feelings, Understand 'who, what, where' questions.

Weekly Provision

- Week 1 - Halloween and Bonfire Night - Discuss how we celebrate these.
- Week 2 - Maths Launch Week - Using number language in stories, rhymes and songs
- Week 3 - Friendship Week - Talk about why we are each special. Special person.
- Week 4 - Road Safety Week — Discuss road safety rules and signs.
- Week 5 - Light and Dark— Talk about how we can see in the dark, what keeps us safe in the dark.
- Week 6 - The First Christmas— Talk about their first Christmas.
- Week 7- Christmas at Home— Talk about what they do at xmas with their family.
- Week 8 - Xmas Party— Discuss games we will play at the party.



Understanding the World

Continuous Provision - Songs, computer activities, natural materials both indoor and outdoors for exploration and investigation. Discuss Christmas traditions. Pretend play around Halloween and Christmas.

Other provision - Talk about light and dark. Operate mechanical toys. Play Christmas games on the computer.

Weekly Provision

- Week 1 - Halloween and Bonfire Night - Discuss celebrations. Make children aware of Guy Fawkes.
- Week 2 - Maths Launch Week - Explore where we see different numbers in the environment.
- Week 3 - Friendship Week - Look at RRSA—Right to have friends.
- Week 4 - Road Safety Week — Road Safety story. Reading Safety signs.
- Week 5 - Light and Dark— Operate torches, explore shadows.
- Week 6 - The First Christmas— Discuss why we celebrate Christmas and how.
- Week 7- Christmas at Home— Discuss Christmas traditions.
- Week 8 - Xmas Party—Discuss games we play with family at Christmas.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

Continuous Provision - Expressing own preferences, interests. Gain inde in child initiated learning and open ended play. Continue to separate from carers.

Other provision - Learn about road safety, talk about Christmas, Halloween and Bonfire traditions. Role play- witches cave and Santa's grotto.

Weekly Provision

- Week 1 - Halloween and Bonfire Night - Keeping safe, dressing up role play.
- Week 2 - Maths Launch Week - Using numbers of personal significance.
- Week 3 - Friendship Week - Discussing why we are special. Special person
- Week 4 - Road Safety Week — Learning about road safety.
- Week 5 - Light and Dark— Discuss feelings.
- Week 6 - The First Christmas— Discuss our family traditions. Sing Christmas songs.
- Week 7- Christmas at Home— Perform 'wriggly nativity' for parents.

Physical Development

Continuous Provision - Show control in pouring milk, using scissors, mark making tools. Support to put on clothing. Increasing independence in self care. and large and small scale construction equipment.

Other provision - Look at pencil grip and control. Finger gym, fine motor skills activities, dough disco.

Weekly Provision

Week 1 - Halloween and Bonfire Night - Imitate drawing simple lines and circles to represent fireworks.

Week 2 - Maths Launch Week - Counting large scale movements until timer runs out.

Week 3 - Friendship Week - Using gross motor skills in dough disco.

Week 4 - Road Safety Week — Road Safety story. Reading Safety signs.

Week 5 - Light and Dark— Dismantle a torch and look inside.

Week 6 - The First Christmas— Use tools and equipment to cook Christmas cakes.

Week 7 - Christmas at Home— Wrap and unwrap presents in the grotto.

Week 8 - Xmas Party— Gross motor skills in party games.
