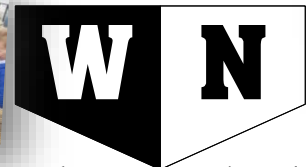


General Information

- Children accessing 30 hour provision will need to bring a packed lunch to school. Lunch supervision costs £10 per week. Please pay every Monday, putting money into a sealed envelope with your child's name on.
- Children are offered fruit for a snack every morning. We ask that you provide water. Please note we are a healthy school and juice is not permitted.
- Children are not allowed to wear jewellery.
- If your child needs medication please contact the school office and fill in the relevant paper work

Nursery Lunches

In line with our packed lunch policy, please provide a healthy packed lunch which includes:

- at least one portion of fruit and one portion of vegetables.
- a portion of meat, fish, eggs, or a non-dairy protein
- a starchy food such as bread, pasta, rice, couscous, noodles or potatoes.
- a dairy food such as milk, cheese, yoghurt, fromage frais or custard.
- a drink of water



Packed lunches can occasionally include:

- sausage rolls, individual pies, corned meat and sausages.
- baked crisps, cakes and biscuits

Packed lunches should not include:

- confectionery such as chocolate bars, chocolate-coated cereal bars, processed fruit bars and sweets.
- sugary soft drinks, such as squash and fizzy drinks.
- Peanut butter and chocolate spread



Please consider the portion sizes that you include in your child's packed lunch.

They should have the amount that they can finish comfortably, with little or no waste.

Please provide your child with:

- A warm and waterproof coat every day (even on sunny days)
- Wellington boots when raining or snowing
- Hats and gloves in cold weather
- Sun cream to be applied before nursery
- A cap in sunnier weather

The nursery day

Nursery sessions

AM: 8.45 - 11.45 (doors open at 11.40)

PM: 12.15 - 3.15 (doors open at 3.10)

30 hour provision: 8.45 - 3.15 (doors open at 3.10)

- Children will stay in the nursery without an accompanying adult. (Children will settle much more easily if adults leave quickly.)
- Please drop your child are dropped off and collected from the nursery door.
- To ensure safeguarding only designated adults are permitted to collect children (Consent forms to be completed).
