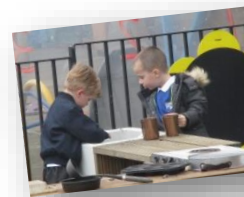

# The nursery day

Nursery sessions:            AM: 8.45 - 11.45 (doors open at 11.40)  
   PM: 12.15 - 3.15 (doors open at 3.10)  
30 hours: 8.45 - 3.15 (doors open at 3.10)

- Children are dropped off and collected from the nursery door.
- Please be on time for pick up. Nursery staff only have 30 mins to tidy nursery for PM session and have their lunch.
- To ensure safeguarding only designated adults are permitted to collect children (Please complete the consent forms)
- Lunch time supervision for 30 hour children costs £10 per week.
- Children need to bring a packed lunch to school.
- Nursery starting dates and times. (In packs)

## Nursery Lunches

**Please provide a healthy packed lunch which includes:**

- at least one portion of fruit and one portion of vegetables.
- a portion of meat, fish, eggs, or a non-dairy protein
- a starchy food such as bread, pasta, rice, couscous, noodles or potatoes.
- a dairy food such as milk, cheese, yoghurt, fromage frais or custard.
- a drink of water

**Packed lunches can occasionally include:**

- sausage rolls, individual pies, corned meat and sausages.
- baked crisps, cakes and biscuits

**Packed lunches should not include:**

- chocolate bars, chocolate-coated cereal bars, processed fruit bars and sweets.
- sugary drinks, such as squash or fizzy drinks.
- Peanut butter and chocolate spread
