
Preparing your child for School

School will be a positive experience for your child if they can make a good attempt at...

- going to the toilet independently
- dressing and undressing
- turning clothes and coats the right way
- using a knife and fork
- sharing and taking turns
- listening to and following simple instructions
- recognise their name and attempt to write it
- recognise numerals 1-10









General Information

- School lunches are universally free until your child goes into Year 3. If
 you wish, your child may bring a packed lunch. Children can switch but
 you must stick to the same choice for the week.
- Children are offered fruit for a snack every morning. We ask that you provide water. Please note we are a healthy school and juice is not permitted.
- Children are not allowed to wear jewellery.
- Please send your child into school every Friday wearing their PE kit.
 Please note that PE will sometimes take place outdoors therefore we advise your child wear joggers / leggings and a hoodie or school jumper.
- If your child needs medication, please contact the school office and fill in the relevant paperwork.







Please label all clothing.




· PE Kit

- Children will come to school wearing their PE kit every Friday









Purchasing School Uniform










The Great Outdoors

Please provide your child with:

- · A warm and waterproof coat every day (even on sunny days)
- ·Hats and gloves in cold weather
- Sun cream (applied before school)
- · A cap in sunnier weather













The school day

School gates will open at 8.35 children can be dropped off after this time until 8.45.

The school day starts at 8.45 and ends at 3.15.

From day one children will say their goodbyes to accompanying adults on the school yard. Please remember children will settle much more easily if adults leave the yard quickly.

Children will be collected from the classroom door. Only designated adults are permitted to collect children. This ensures all children are safeguarded.

If you wish to speak to a member of staff, please wait until all children are in the classroom and a member of staff will be happy to speak to you.







Forms

For those who do not attend Windy Nook Nursery, you will receive a pack of forms to complete, please return these when your child attends transition days.

For those who do attend Windy Nook Nursery, there is a new consent and collection form that needs to be filled in and returned on transition days. If you feel you have any details that have changed or need updated, please collect another pack at the end of the meeting.

Please make sure to return all forms to school on these days, if your child is not able to attend the transition days, please return the forms to the school office by the Monday 1st July.



Transition Days

There are two transition sessions for your child

They will take place on Monday 1st July & Tuesday 2nd July

- Children who do not currently attend Windy Nook Nursery will be invited to attend both morning sessions: 9.30 - 11.30.
- Children who attend Windy Nook Nursery should come to nursery as normal on the transition days. Staff will allocate a morning or afternoon session for the children.

It is advisable for children to attend both sessions, but we appreciate that children might only be able to attend one session.

Friday 6 th September	All children to attend school for the morning session and school lunch: 8.45 - 1.15.
PTFA Coffee Morning	 Children to be dropped off and picked at classroom door.
8.50-10.00	Nursery Gate will be opened at 1.15
Monday 9 th September onwards	All children to attend full session: 8.45 - 3.15

Please note that there is no flexible drop off for the induction week
