Transition



- Most years, 60-70 feeder schools.
- Enhanced transition for vulnerable learners, prior to general transition days – ½ day, with parents/carers.
- Gateshead transition days (usually in the first week of July), followed by a parental open evening at the end of the second day. A lot of SEND information is usually passed on here.
- Information gathering from parents and primary schools, then writing plans prior to Sept inset days.

Additional to Universal Provision

- Use of 'Room 2' and Student Welfare
- In-class support
- Games Club – lunchtime support for vulnerable students
- Supported Study – support with homework
- We also run a variety of interventions on a needs basis:
 - Break times: Chatterbox, Handwriting Intervention, Memory Magic
 - Before school: Fine Motor Mornings, one-to-one check-ins with SEND team staff
 - After-school/co-curriculars: Between the Lines, Young Detectives, Spark Club, The Workshop, Bits and Pieces, Lego Club
- Reading interventions: Lexonik and Reciprocal Reading Groups
- SEMH interventions, such as BU, Represent, Empower, Words that Count, NUF.
